During the month of July, we unfortunately had 103 fly tips reported, in July last year the figure was 90.

All of the FPNs issued are for littering offences. These are largely resulting from 2 overt cameras – one which was in place for fly tipping at Gailey Lea Reservoir and the other at Hilton Main Industrial Estate. The locality 1 FPN is from a witness who provided a statement to us.

We have forwarded 1 X fly tipping and 1 X littering case to Legal for consideration for prosecution.

We are hopeful that our next RIPA authority will be finalised very soon and have the papers completed in anticipation, we continue to operate a few cameras on an overt basis in some of the more prolific areas.

We have provided footage to police regarding a criminal incident at one of our camera sites this month and await an update from them.

5. TREE WORKS

Our tree team are now completing tree works for our residents and businesses bringing additional income into the council, we have received very positive feedback from customers.

We have quoted on 46 Jobs since April 2022 and have been successful in the customer accepting the quote in over 60%. We are also seeing repeat customers which is a credit to the team and the hard work they undertake.

The team have been carrying out site line prune over the district (removing overhanging council owned shrubs from footpaths) to allow residents to freely walk on footpaths. This has meant that we have reduced the commercial aspect for the last 3 months.

We have ensured that any normal and emergency works will been completed by the in-house team rather than outsourcing to Contractors, when possible, which in turn provides saving to the council.

We are looking to commence commercial works over the next few weeks



6. BEREAVEMENT SERVICES

Cemetery Opening Times

Currently, the cemeteries are open to the public seven days a week from 9.00 to 8.00 and are open for burials, including the interment and scattering of ashes, Monday to Friday between 9.00 and 3.00.

Our seasonal opening times are: 1st October to 31st March - 9.00 until 4.30

1st April to 30th September - 9.00 until 8.00

Pre-Purchasing of Plots
